HISTORY

In 1888, in order to meet the growing needs of the parish population, St. Joseph Church under the direction of the Grey Nuns of the Cross of Ottawa (now the Sisters of Charity of Ottawa) opened its own school. Built on a foundation of hard work, faith in God, and the unflinching support of the All Saints parishioners, St. Joseph School still flourishes today. Our rigorous curriculum and focus on Catholic values give our students an advantage in high school and beyond.

LOCATION

CURRICULUM

Our curriculum is based upon the Archdiocesan Guidelines and the Massachusetts Frameworks. Common Core subjects are taught in all grade levels including Math, Science, Language Arts, Social Studies and Religion. We offer a foreign language, French, in Nursery through Grade 8. We also offer Art, Music, Computer, Physical Education and support services in ELA and Math.

Students attend from various local communities including, Haverhill, Lawrence, Merrimac, Methuen, Groveland, NH - Atkinson, Hampstead, Kingston, Plaistow.
